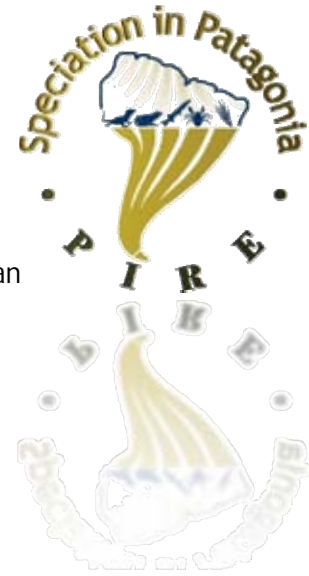


Webmaster Needed
